Community Service Requirements



Glenridge Lions are challenged to take action in their communities all year long whenever a need arises.

Minimum requirements:

6th and 7th graders	1 Take Action experience per nine weeks, complete a CANVAS reflection
8th graders	Complete a Community Project

- 6th and 7th grade students may use one summer Take Action experience to fulfill the first nine weeks requirement.
- 6th and 7th grader will reflect on Take Action experiences at the end of each nine weeks.
- Sth grade students must successfully complete the Community Project to earn the Glenridge IB MYP Certificate in May.
- Students do not need to record hours of service.
