Pediatric Nurse Practitioner services are available through the financial support of The Winter Park Health Foundation in partnership with Healthcare Providers of Florida. The Nurse Practitioners provide care at School-Based Health Centers that are located at Glenridge Middle School and Winter Park High School.

Common Reasons for a child or adolescent to come to a School-Based Health Center

- Physical examinations - school entry, sports, Special Olympics, daycare and camp
- Evaluation, diagnosis and treatment of the common conditions of childhood such as asthma, ear infections, allergies etc.
- Writing of prescriptions when indicated
- Referral to specialists
- Additional health education and screening
- Transfer of up to date shot records to the required Florida form

We do not provide: Lab, x-ray, immunizations, birth control and ADHD Prescriptions
