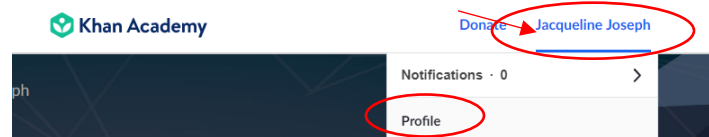

How to Log in to Khan Academy to complete your summer assignment:

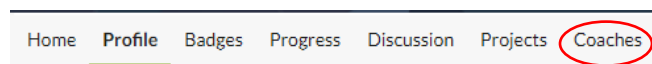
- If you have an OCPS student account:
 1. Go to khanacademy.org
 2. Click on the sign-in link on the top right-hand side of the screen
 3. Log in to Khan Academy with Google.
 4. Use your OCPS email account to log in.

 - Password: Your OCPS password
- If you do NOT have an OCPS student account (new to the district):
 1. Go to khanacademy.org
 2. Click on the sign in/ sign up link on the top right-hand side of the screen
 3. If you do not have a Khan Academy account, at the bottom of the list select “create a new account.”

Enter a class code or your teacher's email address:

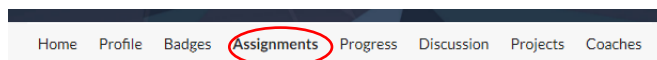
